

Postdoctoral Position in Mathematics

- Position:** One or more three-year, non-tenure-track postdoctoral faculty positions in the Department of Mathematics at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.
- Qualifications:** Candidates should have a Ph.D. in the mathematical sciences by the starting date and documented potential for research and teaching in mathematics. Applicant's research should be in one of the areas in which the UNL's mathematics faculty has expertise. Preference will be given to applicants within three years of having received the Ph.D.
- Starting Date:** August 2021
- First Review:** Review of applications will begin March 26, 2021, and continue until a suitable candidate has been selected.
- Duties/Responsibilities:** Teaching responsibilities include graduate and undergraduate courses in mathematics. A three-course teaching load for the academic year is anticipated.
- Salary/Benefits:** The position will have a competitive starting salary. Some travel support is available. UNL makes available life, health, and long-term disability insurance programs as well as family coverage at reasonable group rates to the employee.
- Applications:** Applicants should submit letter of application, a CV, statements addressing research and teaching, and three or four letters of reference, at least one of which should address teaching.
