

Postdoctoral Position in Mathematics

- Position:** Two three-year, non-tenure-track postdoctoral faculty positions in the Department of Mathematics at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.
- Qualifications:** Candidates must have a Ph.D. in mathematics, mathematics education, or a closely related field, by the start date. The successful candidate will demonstrate potential for excellence in research and have a documented record of excellence in classroom instruction at the college level. Preference will be given to candidates whose research interests align with the research strengths of the department.
- Starting Date:** August 2023
- First Review:** Review of applications will begin December 5, 2022 and continue until suitable candidates have been selected.
- Duties/Responsibilities:** The position is apportioned 60% research, 40% teaching. Teaching duties include teaching three courses per academic year. There will also be opportunities to mentor undergraduate research.
- Salary/Benefits:** A competitive salary will be negotiated. Some travel support is available. UNL makes available life, health, and long-term disability insurance programs with a faculty retirement plan, which includes significant institutional contribution.
- Applications:** Applicants should submit an application letter, a CV, separate statements addressing research and teaching, and at least three letters of reference, at least one of which should address the applicant's teaching. The Department of Mathematics particularly welcomes applicants who can contribute to a diverse and inclusive environment through their scholarship, teaching, mentoring, and professional service. Applicants are encouraged to use the AMS application cover sheet and to submit their application via mathjobs.org.
